Bridge Records announces the October 11, 2011 release of the new CD by the Weiss-Kaplan-Newman Trio.

Johannes Brahms: Trio No. 1 in B Major, Op. 8
Bedrich Smetana: Piano Trio in G minor, Op. 15

This CD of Brahms and Smetana trios is the Weiss-Kaplan-Newman Trio's first full recording for Bridge Records. Previously, Bridge issued the Trio's recording of Paul Chihara's "Ain't No Sunshine" (BRIDGE 9267).

Combining the talents of three award-winning soloists, the Weiss-Kaplan-Newman Trio was hailed by The New York Times as "Three strong voices, locked in sequence". The Weiss-Kaplan-Newman Trio was founded in 2001 (originally as Sequenza Trio), and has presented concerts throughout the US, Europe and the Middle East, with appearances at The Kennedy Center, Wigmore Hall, Princeton, UCLA, Indiana and Oxford Universities, Tel-Aviv Museum, and for the Chamber Music Societies of Edinburgh, Santander among numerous others. The Trio is known for its performances of Beethoven's complete cycle of works for Piano Trio, as well as for their commitment to new compositions.
