Digital Dose: New classical discs feature music by Brahms... and Smetana

Both of the works on this disc were written during the mid-1850s, though Brahms greatly revised his trio several decades later. The pieces share a sweeping Romanticism that the members of the Weiss-Kaplan-Newman Trio set forth to splendid effect. The Brahms (in the final 1889 version) receives a performance full of warmth and vitality, as does the Smetana trio, a neglected score written after the death of the composer's young daughter.
